## International Chess Day





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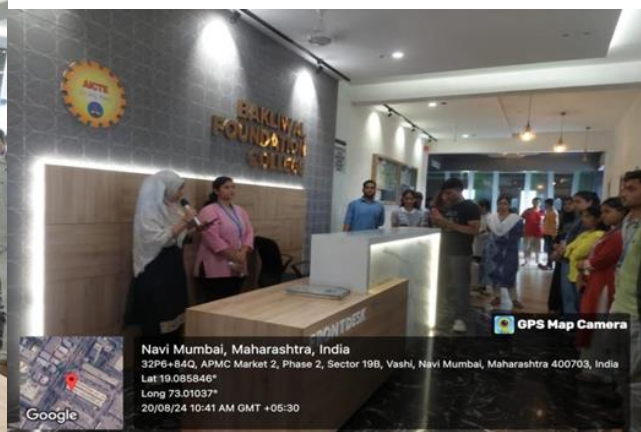

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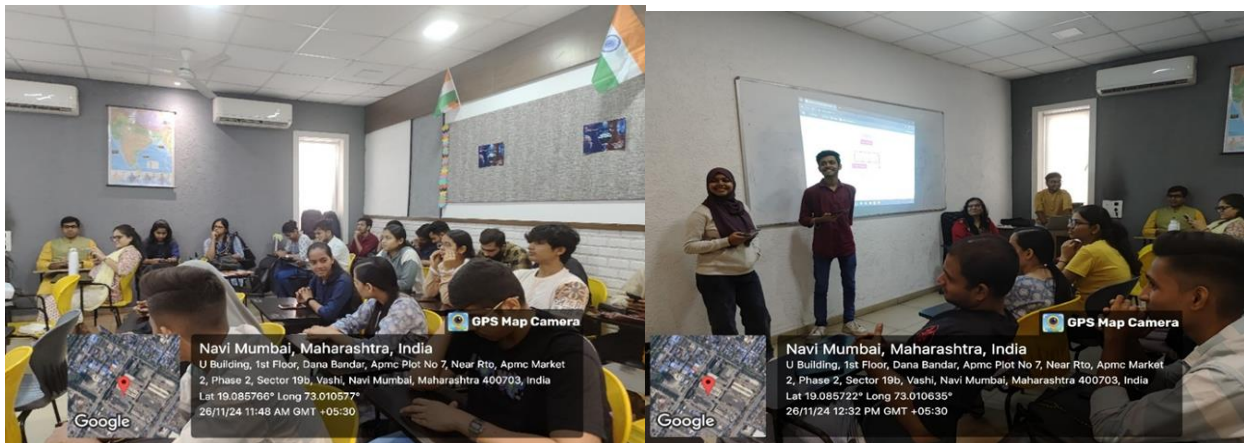

## Career Counselling Session for B.A. Civil Services Students



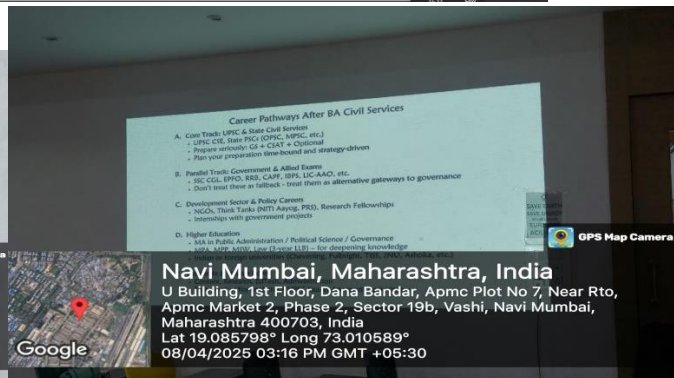
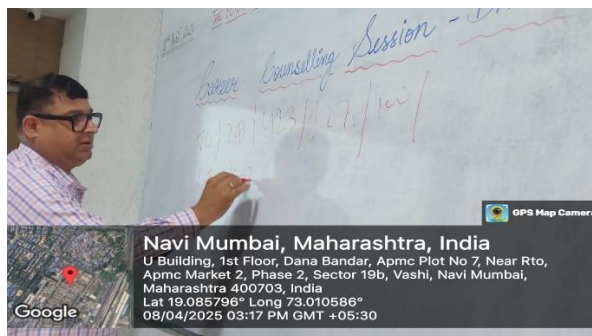
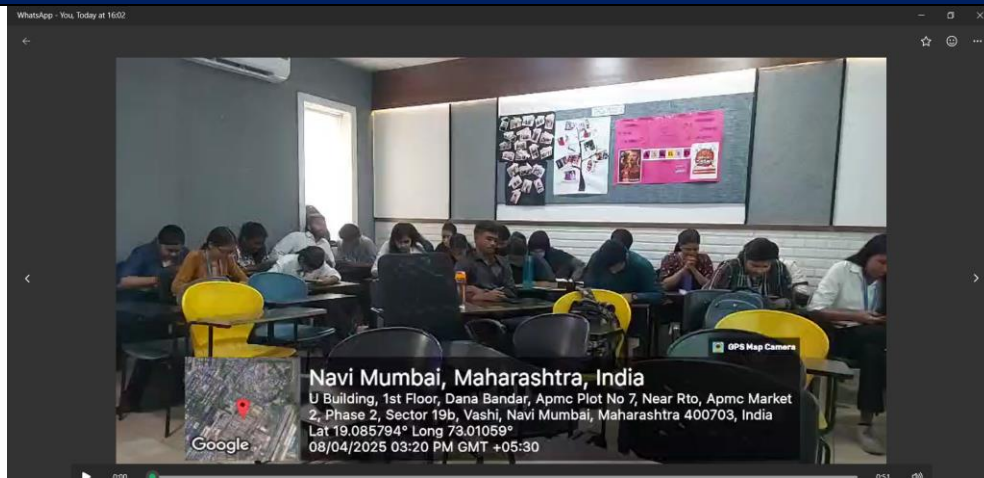
