"As a NEP SAARTHI, the government has taken a significant step to make education more accessible and effective. This scheme introduces vocational and technical learning opportunities, such as gardening, tailoring, and carpentry, for students in the middle stages, spanning from class 6 to 8. The scheme also offers flexibility with multiple subjects, encourages critical thinking, and eliminates stream barriers, allowing students to choose subjects based on their interests. After thorough consideration, I have both positive and negative opinions about NEP 2020.

Positive Aspects:

1. The Indian government allocates 6% of its GDP for education, a substantial commitment to improving the education system.
2. The emphasis on vocational education provides practical knowledge and skills that can be invaluable for students' future careers.
3. The initiative to attract 50 foreign universities to open branches in India can enhance the quality of higher education.
4. NEP 2020's organizational structure, consisting of different departments for syllabus development, infrastructure, student scholarships, and result management, is a well-thought-out approach to manage the education system effectively.
5. Extending teacher training to four years aims to produce highly competent educators.

Negative Aspects:

1. The exclusion of Mandarin (Chinese language) from the curriculum may limit students' exposure to a crucial global language.
2. The negligence of English, which is widely used internationally, could hinder students' competitiveness on the global stage.
3. Centralized decision-making regarding teacher programs might lead to a lack of flexibility and adaptation to local needs.
4. The evaluation of teacher aptitude is a concern that needs careful consideration to ensure the quality of educators."

Green club and N.S.S initiatives of Ganapati Nirmalya and Swachh Bharat drive :

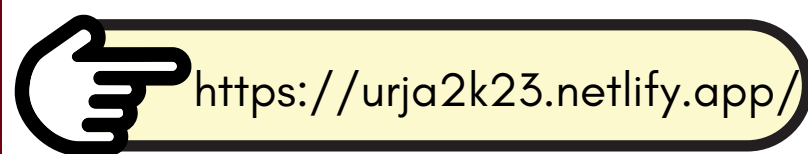
