Organize events on days like World Environment Day, Earth Day, and World Water Day to engage and inspire the college community.

#### The activities under the scheme include:

- ♣ Motivate the students to keep their surroundings green and clean by undertaking the plantation of trees.
- ♣ Promote the ethos of conservation of water by minimizing the use of water.
- Motivate students to imbibe habits and lifestyles for minimum waste generation, source separation of waste, and disposal of the waste to the nearest storage point.
- Leducate students to create awareness amongst public and sanitary workers to stop the indiscriminate burning of waste which causes respiratory diseases.
- ♣ Sensitize the students to minimize the use of plastic bags, not to throw them in public places as they choke drains and sewers, cause water logging and provide breeding grounds for mosquitoes.
- ♣ Organize tree plantation programs, and awareness programs such as quizzes, essays, painting competitions, rallies, nukkad natak etc. regarding various environmental issues and educate children about the re-use of waste material & preparation of products out of waste.
- ♣ Organize Nature Trails in Wild Life Sanctuaries/Parks/Forest areas to know about the Bio-diversity

- ✓ Advocate that the City replace older vehicles in the City fleet by purchasing hybrids, electric, or alternative vehicles.
- ✓ Create, and develop local gardens for resident Adults, youth, and families to participate in learning the skills in farming and growing food.
- ✓ Promote and encourage the City to continue the Farmer's Market.
- ✓ Investigate the town's need for an indoor farmer's market during the fall and winter months.
- ✓ Encourage street art and public engagement to create a cohesive branding strategy for a vibrant community. (Banner Competition)
- ✓ Continue to work on ways to protect the Bay with wetlands and plantings.
- ✓ Work with the Housing Societies and Garden Club on events and to promote stewardship in homes with gardens, plants, and trees.
- ✓ Assist the city with the Annual event "Plant the City" to plant trees, flowers.
- ✓ Create a recycling education program for residents through print, video, and other media.
- ✓ Support City and State goals toward waste reduction.
- ✓ Continue to promote a clean City, and encourage cooperation from the public through the Annual Community Clean-up Program and other educational tools, to protect the Chesapeake Bay from trash.
