#### 1] Originality & Plagiarism:



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All content submitted must be original. Plagiarism will not be tolerated and may result in disqualification from publishing.

#### 2] Accuracy & Verification:

News articles must be factual and well-researched. Any data or claims must be backed by reliable sources or verification.

#### 3] Respect & Sensitivity:

Articles must avoid derogatory, discriminatory, or inflammatory language. Content must respect all cultures, genders, communities, and ideologies.

#### 4] Editorial Approval:

All submissions are subject to review, editing, and approval by the Editorial Board to maintain quality and alignment with the publication's values.

#### 5] Inclusive Representation:

Efforts should be made to include voices from all departments, backgrounds, and disciplines within the college.

#### 6] No Political or Controversial Propaganda:

The publication must remain neutral and must not promote political agendas or ideologically sensitive issues without balanced representation.

### 7] Confidentiality:

Internal college matters or information not meant for public disclosure must not be published without prior permission.

### 8] Copyright and Credits:



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Proper credit must be given to contributors, photographers, and sources. Copyrighted material should not be used without permission.

#### 9] Submission Deadlines:

Contributors must adhere to deadlines set by the editorial team to ensure timely publication.
