1] Adoption of Schools

Providing assistance with meeting the needs of schools will be initially achieved through close involvement with NGOs, and this led to the development of a full-fledged and independent adoption model of a Government Model Primary School Panvel Taluka, District Raigad, State Maharashtra.



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Bakliwal Foundation College of Arts, Commerce & Science, Vashi, [BFCACS] would like to donate liberally to the school thereafter and assist with infrastructural aid besides providing facilities like:

- ✓ Construction of a compound wall with the main gate, to safeguard the premises-executed and completed.
- ✓ Construction of a kitchen and storeroom with RCC roofing, within the school premises.
- ✓ Construction of separate toilets for boys and girls
- ✓ Drinking water facilities & water connections.
- ✓ Books, stationery, and uniforms.
- ✓ Periodical camps by NSS / Green Club students of BFCACS to promote awareness of social issues, and as a part of community service.
